## **Learning Focus**

As we dive into our exciting Maths journey from Nursery to Year 6, it's important to remember that Maths is all about patterns and the relationships between numbers. It's not just something we do in the classroom; it surrounds us in everyday life, from counting items in the shop to exploring shapes in art and architecture.

In Nursery, children might do two jumps for the number 2 or pop three bananas into their trolley. By Reception, they'll match numbers to their values from 0 to 10. Year 1 introduces counting in 1s, 5s, and 10s, while Year 2 focuses on confident adding and subtracting up to 10, alongside number bonds to 100.

As they progress, Year 3 will master their 3, 4, and 8 times tables, and by Year 4, all times tables will be firmly in their grasp. Year 5 and Year 6 build on this knowledge, allowing children to tackle

more complex calculations. Let's keep encouraging our little mathematicians; the world of numbers is truly wonderful!

What a busy week we've had at William Stockton! We're absolutely thrilled to announce the return of the book fair next week—an exciting opportunity for our students to explore new reads. We also welcomed the Director of Education from our multi-academy trust, who validated our hard work and was truly impressed by our wonderful pupils, their impressive work, and our dedicated staff.
