Learning Focus

As we approach the end of our history units this term, it's fantastic to see the children's enthusiasm for learning about the past! History is important as it provides a sense of the past and an understanding of the development of various values, systems, and societies.

In **Nursery**, the little ones have been sequencing photos of their lives from babyhood to now which starts our **locality thread**.

Reception have been exploring Grandma's suitcase from Little Red Riding Hood, discovering how things have changed over the years which links to thread about how **society has changed**. **Year 1** has delved into the life of King Charles III and learned about Queen Elizabeth II and is where the children first encounter the idea of **Power**. **Year 2** has pondered the consequences of the Great Fire of London and how houses are now built differently showing how **society has changed over time**.

In **Years 3 and 4**, they've debated whether Alfred the Great was indeed 'great', while **Years 5 and 6** uncovered the roots of democracy during the English Civil War. Both of these topics, think about the thread Power and how **power** can change the way people live.
