## Learning Focus

As we approach the next half term, we thought you'd like to know what exciting **geography** topics the children will be diving into. In **Nursery**, little explorers will focus on maps, using their imagination in small world play to create their own. They'll share stories about places they've been and use positional language like "forwards" and "backwards" to describe their adventures.

**Reception** will embark on a journey around the globe, comparing different environments, inspired by their books and own experiences. **Year 1** will explore China, uncovering the similarities and differences

with the UK thinking about the human and physical features. In **Year 2**, pupils will ponder the question: would you prefer to live in a hot or cold country? They'll learn that temperatures increase closer to the equator and that colder countries are further away from it.

Year 3/4 will investigate where our food comes from, discovering how climate zones affect where the food is grown and how this means it needs to be imported.

Lastly, **Year 5/6** will brainstorm ways to make our local area greener conducting their own research and campaigning for change
