arning Focus

As your now dence education is crucial for our children as it fosters a deeper understanding of the world around them. This term, we have an exciting array of topics lined up for our young scientists! In **Nursery**, the children will marvel at the lifecycle of a butterfly, observing the magical transformation from caterpillar to butterfly. **Reception** will delve into the world of plants, planting their own and naming wildflowers like daisies and dandelions while observing their growth over time.

Year 1 will continue with plants, investigating how the colour of strawberries affects taste—what an experiment!

In Year 2, pupils will learn that plants need water, light, and warmth to flourish and will explore how to conduct a fair test.

Years 3 and 4 will dive into forces and magnets, discovering push and pull forces and distinguishing between magnetic and non-magnetic materials. Lastly, Years 5 and 6 will embark on the fascinating subject of evolution, exploring how animals adapt over time and investigating bird beak variations and how the food available has caused bird beaks to adapt. What a fun-filled Science term!
