## **Learning Focus**

This week in school has been a History focus, and it's been wonderful to see our William Stockton children from Nursery to Year 6 diving into historical learning! They've been actively exploring primary and secondary sources, and their use of historical language has been superb. In Nursery, the focus has been on sequencing events they've witnessed, particularly from their recent experience with butterflies. Reception is gearing up to learn about dinosaurs, sparking much excitement! Year 1 has been exploring Victorian holidays, identifying elements like the promenade, pier, and arcade. Year 2 has considered whether Sir Francis Drake was an explorer or a pirate, thoughtfully evaluating evidence.

Year 3/4 studied both William the Conqueror and King John, interpreting evidence about his reputation. Lastly, Year 5/6 focused on propaganda from the World Wars, discussing its potential effects on modern-day enlistment. What a fantastic week of historical exploration!

Walking around the school this week, I've been so pleased to see just how ready the children are to move on to their next stage of learning.
