This week in school has been a History focus, and it's been wonderful to see our William Stockton children from Nursery to Year 6 diving into historical learning! They've been actively exploring primary and secondary sources, and their use of historical language has been superb. In Nursery, the focus has been on sequencing events they've witnessed, particularly from their recent experience with butterflies. Reception is gearing up to learn about dinosaurs, sparking much excitement! Year 1 has been exploring Victorian holidays, identifying elements like the promenade, pier, and arcade.
